

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SIGNING A CODICIL

1. If it is the Codicil of one party, such party and two witnesses must sign the Codicil in the presence of one another.
2. If it is the Codicil of two parties, both such parties and two witnesses must sign the Codicil in the presence of one another.
3. Neither of the witnesses to the Will must be related either by blood or marriage to:
 - 3.1. The party or parties whose Will they are witnessing
 - 3.2. The Executor appointed in terms of the Will or his/her spouse
 - 3.3. Any of the beneficiaries named in the Will or his/her spouse
4. Each page of the Codicil must be signed (full signatures NOT initials) by each party or parties to the Codicil and the two witnesses in the places indicated.
5. The date on which the Codicil is signed and the place where it is signed must be inserted on the last page in the place indicated.
6. Please complete the names and addresses of the two witnesses signing the Codicil where indicated on the last page.
7. Please do not amend the Codicil. If any changes need to be made, please let us know and we shall attend to the alterations.
