

## Construction management profession's training institutions to accredit

The SACPCMP ("SA Council for the Project and Construction Management Professions") has issued a [notice](#) in the Government Gazette of 30 September which announces the development of an **Accreditation Policy** for learning institutions.

It appears from the notice that the Council's objective for establishing an **Accreditation Policy** is to assess learning institutions against a predetermined set of requirements to ensure competency and desired professional conduct amongst graduates, and thereby maintaining quality skills within the built environment.

The Policy states in its preamble that 'Accreditation is therefore vital for the continued sustainability of the Council and its underlying professions.'
